Usage Manager “Full Control” User Permission Affords Administrators Full Management Access to All Users’ Reports Folders

Versions Affected

- ETM[®] System v5.3 and later (Federal customers)
- ETM System v6.0.x and later (Commercial customers)

Synopsis

A new available user permission affords administrators full visibility of all other users’ reports folders and full control of the contents of those folders. For new installations, this permission is enabled by default for only the default **admin** account. For upgrades from a previous version that did not provide this permission, the permission is disabled by default for all accounts and can be selected manually.

This document corrects the information in the *ETM[®] System Administration Guide* and *Usage Manager User Guide*, Releases 5.3 and 6.0, and associated online Help.

More Information

When the Usage Manager **Full Control** permission is granted to a user account, it affords the account holder the ability to schedule reports for other users, create/edit/delete all objects in the private folder of other users, and use the **Save to Tree** option to store generated reports in other users’ private folders. Users to whom this permission is not granted cannot see other users’ private folders in the Usage Manager tree pane.
